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Middle School

The Middle School of Denbigh Baptist Christian School incorporates grades 6-8. The intention of the Middle School is to thoroughly prepare students for the challenges and independence of thought and work required in the High School.

To that end, paper packets and assignment sheets are no longer sent home. Students are issued an assignment planner at the beginning of the year. They are expected to keep daily and long term assignments in this. They are also expected to keep a binder for each subject organized. Students change classes, and are expected to be responsible for their assignments and books, which they keep in individual lockers.

The intention of our curriculum is to provide our students with the opportunity to continue to explore the fine arts and to attain computer skills, as well as to pursue traditional academic endeavors. Our academic curriculum includes the opportunity to take World Geography, as well as mathematics and foreign language classes for high school credit in the eighth grade *if specific pre-requisites are met*.

Extra-Curricular Opportunities

Middle School students are eligible to compete on athletic teams at both the middle school, junior varsity, and, for exceptional eighth graders, varsity, level. For soccer, volleyball, (w), and basketball, we field middle school teams. Baseball, softball, tennis, cheerleading, cross country, and track include both middle school and junior varsity players, as demand dictates.

The eighth grade elects class officers, and participates in the SCA as well. Middle School students may also participate in the JOY Club. Music theory, choir, art, and computers are an integral part of the 6th and 7th grade curriculum, as well as for those eighth graders who are not enrolled in Spanish I.
